**INVITATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR  
STRUCTURED ENGINEERS APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME  
(SEAP) - 2009/2010**

The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has allocated some funds through the Ministry of Infrastructure Development during the 2009/2010 financial year towards the implementation of the Structured Engineers Apprenticeship Programme (SEAP). Implementation of the SEAP programme will enable Tanzania Graduate Engineers to acquire professional experience in a structured manner and thus to qualify for registration as professional engineers.

The Engineers Registration Board (ERB), a statutory body established under the Act of Parliament (Act No. 15 of 1997 as amended by Engineers Registration (amendment) Act No 24 of 2007), is the implementing agency of the programme. The Board now invites applications from **Graduate Engineers** employed by the Government Ministries and Institutions and the **2009 Graduate Engineers** from Higher Learning Institutions. The applicants must be holders of degrees or advanced diplomas in engineering disciplines from any of the following Institutions: The College of Engineering and Technology (CoET), Sokoine University of Agriculture (SUA), Dar es Salaam Institute of Technology (DIT), Ardhi University (ARU), Mbeya Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), Saint Joseph College of Engineering and Technology or any other recognized local or foreign engineering training institutions. Women Graduate Engineers are highly recommended to apply.

Applicants are required to submit letters of applications and under listed documents:

1. A duly completed "Application Form for SEAP" obtainable from the office of the Registrar or website;
2. Certified copies of degree/diploma certificates and academic transcripts;
3. Two (2) passport size coloured photographs;
4. Names of three (3) referees, one of whom must be from the institution where the applicants studied engineering; and
5. Evidence of registration with the Engineers Registration Board (ERB) as GE or GTE.

Applications should reach the Registrar at the address shown below not later than **15<sup>th</sup> October 2009**.
